Through an annual film festival, year-round Fulldome Forums webinars, the Best of Earth fulldome awards coalition, and community programming, the organization expands public access to immersive cinema, surfaces excellence in the field, and builds a sustained creator community for this emerging art form. All activities are directly aligned with and are executed in support of this educational purpose, in accordance with section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.</u>

Objective: To advance education and appreciation of fulldome and immersive media by producing the annual Dome Fest West film festival. Accomplishments: Produced the 4th annual Dome Fest West May 1 through 4, 2025 at Fiske Planetarium, the second consecutive festival at the venue and the most expansive edition in DFW history. The festival expanded across multiple CU Boulder venues including the Fiske Dome Theater, Kittredge KCEN Hall and Stage, and three Village Center rooms. Launched the inaugural Fulldome Forward Expo as a trade component including an exhibits hall and presentations stage for the immersive media industry. Presented 44 films and immersive works from 14 countries across 11 screening sessions in Fiske, plus 18 or more panel and roundtable sessions on topics ranging from fulldome storytelling to spatial audio standards, LED technology, financial models for immersive creators, and licensing and distribution. Concluded with two awards ceremonies including the inaugural Best of Earth international fulldome awards (DFW served as founding partner) presented alongside the established DFW awards across 15 categories. The City of Boulder issued an official proclamation recognizing Dome Fest West Week. Measurement: Total event participants approximately</u> (Continued on Schedule O, Statement 3)

Objective: To advance year-round public education on fulldome and immersive media by hosting free, publicly accessible online webinars featuring industry experts. Accomplishments: Hosted Fulldome Forums webinar installments throughout calendar year 2025 covering topics including advanced acoustic strategies for immersive venues (March 2025), innovative sound strategies for immersive creators (April 2025), key principles for innovative dome venue design (June 2025), interactive fulldome explorations (July 2025), exploring innovative revenue streams for planetariums (August 2025), securing resources for fulldome vision (September 2025), monetizing live theatrical productions in domes (November 2025), and the revival of planetarium lasers (December 2025). Schedule L, Part II - During the tax year, Dome Fest West continued to carry outstanding non-interest-bearing loans from three officers received in 2022 to cover costs of the 2022 festival edition: Ryan Moore (Executive Director) \$8,622; Kate McCallum (Board Member) \$1,052; Ed Lantz (Board Chair) \$791; total \$10,465. These loans are unsecured, non-interest-bearing, and repayable on demand. The board of directors approved acceptance of these loans and has been kept apprised of the outstanding balances. No principal repayments were made during 2025. No interest accrued. The organization intends to repay these loans as cash flow permits. The board has had preliminary discussions about the lenders earmarking the loans as charitable contributions in a future period, but no action has been taken and no forgiveness has occurred. During the prior tax year (2024), these loans were correctly disclosed on Schedule L Part II of the Form 990-EZ but were omitted from Part II Line 26 (Total liabilities) of that return. The current return correctly reports the loans on Part X Line 22 with the offsetting adjustment recorded via Part XI Line 9 (Other changes in net assets), as further explained in Schedule O.

Form 990, Part VI, Section A, Line 2 - Kate McCallum, Board Member, provides consulting services to Vortex Immersion Media. Ed Lantz, Board Chair, is the CEO of Vortex Immersion Media. This is a pre-existing professional relationship in the immersive media industry; neither party receives compensation from Dome Fest West, and both serve on the DFW board independently of their Vortex relationship.

Form 990, Part VI, Section B, Line 11b - The 2025 Form 990 was prepared by the Executive Director using QuickBooks Online financial data and reviewed against the prior year return. A draft was provided to the Board of Directors for review prior to filing, with all board members given an opportunity to ask questions and provide feedback. The final return was reviewed and approved by the Executive Director as the signing officer and filed with the Internal Revenue Service. The organization retained a paid preparer to perform the final review and electronic filing.

Form 990, Part VI, Section C, Line 19 - Dome Fest West makes its governing documents (Articles of Incorporation, Bylaws) and most recent financial statements (Form 990) available to the public upon written request, in accordance with Internal Revenue Code section 6104. The organization's conflict of interest policy is made available to board members upon their election and disclosed publicly upon written request. The organization does not currently post these documents on its website but may do so in the future as part of ongoing transparency improvements.

Form 990, Part XI, Line 9 - During 2025, the organization recognized \$10,465 of previously unrecorded officer loan liabilities. The loans were received from three officers in 2022 to cover costs of the 2022 festival edition (Ryan Moore \$8,622; Kate McCallum \$1,052; Ed Lantz \$791). The loans were correctly disclosed on Schedule L Part II of the prior return (Form 990-EZ for tax year 2024) but were omitted from Part II Line 26 (Total liabilities) on that return. The current return reflects the loans on Part X Line 22 with detail on Schedule L Part II. The recognition of these liabilities reduces Net Assets by \$10,465 and is reflected on Line 9 of this reconciliation. Line 8 prior period adjustments of \$1,692 reflects reconciliation differences identified during the 2025 review of accounting records to the prior return. Specifically, this captures the difference between QuickBooks Online's running Net Assets account at 1/1/2025 and the prior return's reported ending Net Assets, net of the officer loan correction described on Line 9.

Dome Fest West is an all-volunteer 501(c)(3) public charity in its second tax year of recognized exempt status, having received its IRS determination letter dated June 20, 2024 (Letter 947, DLN 26053686005083, effective June 5, 2024). The organization has no paid staff and no employees; all operational, financial, and compliance work is performed by volunteer officers and directors in addition to their other commitments. The 2025 tax year was the organization's most operationally intensive to date, including the production of its 4th annual Dome Fest West film festival May 1 through 4, 2025 at Fiske Planetarium at the University of Colorado Boulder, the inaugural Fulldome Forward Expo, and partnership in the inaugural Best of Earth international fulldome awards. The festival required the full attention of the organization's volunteer team through late April 2025, with post-festival reporting, sponsor stewardship, and program wrap-up extending into the following months. Following the festival, in preparing the 2025 return, the organization identified several prior-period accounting matters that required investigation and reconciliation before the return could be accurately completed. These included recognition of \$10,465 in officer loans that had been disclosed on the prior return's Schedule L but were omitted from the prior balance sheet, reconciliation of the organization's accounting records to the prior return for purposes of Part XI, reclassification of a \$15,000 grant that had been misclassified in the organization's books, and proper application of the IRS donated-services exclusion rule to an in-kind services transaction. The organization also undertook two required state registrations during this period (California Statement of Information filed March 23, 2026, and Colorado Statement of Foreign Entity Authority filed March 23, 2026) that consumed additional volunteer bandwidth. Despite these challenges, the organization exercised ordinary business care and prudence in the preparation of its 2025 return. The organization performed a comprehensive reconciliation of its books to the prior return, engaged independent review of its return positions, retained a paid preparer to perform final review and electronic filing, and provided a complete draft to the Board of Directors for review prior to filing. The organization respectfully requests that any late filing penalty under section 6652(c)(1)(A) be abated for reasonable cause. The organization is fully committed to timely filing in future tax years and is implementing improved internal processes, including earlier engagement of professional support, to ensure on-time filing going forward.
